10	Assisted the patient to the high Fowler's position or elevated the head of the bed 45 degrees if the patient is unable to maintain upright position.

	Draped chest with bath towel or disposable pad. Measured the distance to insert tube by placing tip of tube at patient's nostril and extending to tip			
12	of earlobe and then to tip of xiphoid process.			
13	Marked the length of the tube for insertion with a permanent marker.			
14	Put on gloves.			
15	Lubricated tip of tube (at least 5-10cm) with water-soluble lubricant.			
16	Asked patient to slightly flex head back against the pillow.			
17	Gently inserted the tube into the nostril while directing the tube upward and backward along the			
	floor of the nose.			
18	Offered comfort and reassurance to the patient.			
19	When pharynx was reached, instructed patient to touch chin to the chest.			
20	Encouraged patient to sip water through a straw or swallow even if no fluids were permitted.			
21	Advanced tube in downward and backward direction when patient swallowed.			
22	Kept advancing tube until pen marking was reached.			
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23	Secured the tube loosely to the nose or cheek until it was determined that the tube is in the patient's stomach.									
24	Attached syringe to end of tube and aspirated a small amount of stomach contents.

26	Visually checked aspirated contents, checking for colour and consistency.									
27	Applied skin barrier to tip and end of nose and allowed to dry.									
28	Removed gloves and secured tube tape to patient's nose with tape.									
29	Secured tube to patient's gown by using rubber band or tape and safety pin.									
30	Put on gloves.									
31	Clamped tube.									
32	Removed syringe and capped the tube or attached drainage bag.									
33	Measured length of exposed tube.									
34	Repeated marking on tube at nostril with a permanent marker.
