(Köni, Rosli & Mohamad Zin, 2015).




Hyper Secularisation

(M. Hakan Yavuz, 2003 :56).






Progress over Time

Bawamurad (2012) commented as follows:

"Our Islamism identity has been occurred in counter to secularism. Basically, Islamic political parties have been established on the basis of opposing colonialism and the alien values to our societies. For that, this has continued up-till the current time. Then, from 1920s onward, the Marxist and Secular orientations came to exist. Because these orientations fundamentally were anti religion movements, the Islamist movements had to continue to defend the religious values. So, the Islamic movements are generally reactions to protect the Islamic values and preaching".

Ramadan (2013) comments on this point:

“I do not define Shari'ah as a legal corpus of Islamic law. For me, in the Quran, Shari'ah is defined as “the way”. The most important thing for me is the objectives of the law such as justice and equality. To be faithful to these objectives is to truly be within Shariah”.


A Distinct Case: Merging within Secularism

the *Democratic Party* (DP) headed by Prime Minister Adnan Menderes won 503 seats in the National Assembly. The *Republican People's Party* (CHP) won 31 seats in the National Assembly.
