Instructions:

Kindly follow the steps below to prepare a perfect presentation

1. Start by choosing the topic

- ⊕ Choose a topic that **genuinely interests you, something you have read and thought deeply about.**
- ⊕ Your topic must carry a meaningful message. (**TEDx Style**)

2. Now, start prepare to present (get information about the topic)

- ⊕ **Research your topic thoroughly** from credible sources.
- ⊕ Draft a clear **outline** (introduction, main message, conclusion). – **This is your message – Remember, it is very important part**
- ⊕ Create a **strong, visually appealing PowerPoint** (or similar visual aid).
You need to take care about the design, don't put all the information.

3. Presentation

- ⊕ Speak **without reading from your slides or notes**. Maintain eye contact and engage your audience naturally. (**We need to gain the trust of the participants first**)
- ⊕ Your talk should feel authentic, passionate, and professional. (**Make sure not to let the negative intrapersonal discussion affect you.**)
- ⊕ Some lecturers and external evaluators may be invited to observe.
(**Prepare yourself**)

4. Duration: 7–10 minutes (Maximum). Don't exceed. Practice well. Be Careful, having less time doesn't mean less information. Make sure to prepare a good-quality presentation.

5. Use of AI:

- ⊕ **AI is not permitted** for generating the presentation script, speech, or content.
- ⊕ Any misuse of AI or plagiarism will result in **course failure**.
- ⊕ Please, don't try to humanise the text to look human-written.
