<b>Responsible</b>	<b>Step</b>	<b>Time Range (dates)</b>
<b>Lecturers</b>	Proposing a minimum of three research directions or subtopics that align with his/her research interests and area of expertise.	
<b>Student</b>	Selecting a relevant and feasible topic for the graduation project	
<b>Departmental Scientific Committee</b>	Assigning the students Project Supervisors	
<b>Head of Department</b>	Announcing the titles of the projects on TIU official platforms	
<b>Supervisors</b>	Submitting "Graduation Project Proposal Form" to be evaluated by the GRP committee	
<b>Supervisors and Students</b>	Signing the "Graduation Project Supervision Agreement"	
<b>Head of Department</b>	Announcing the "4/5th Year Supervision List" on TIU official platforms	
<b>Head of Department</b>	Establishing the Research Project Committee	
<b>Research Project Committee</b>	Arranging seminars to demonstrate the Graduation Research Project Manual	
<b>Supervisor</b>	Holding Student-Supervisor Meetings	Minimum twice a month
<b>Research Project Committee</b>	Preparing a list of GP Defense Committees for all the projects	
<b>Student</b>	Submitting the draft thesis to the GP Defense Committee for review	
<b>GP Defense Committee</b>	Evaluating the quality of research, methodology, and adherence to academic standards.	

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<b>Student</b>	Incorporating feedback from the GP Defense Committee and revising the thesis accordingly, then submitting the final version of the thesis to the Committee	
<b>Student and GP Defense Committee</b>	GP Final Defense	
<b>GP Defense Committee</b>	Submitting the GP grade to the Head of Department
